









Privacy e Cookie policy

	<p>The following privacy policy – in accordance with Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 General Data Protection Regulation – is aimed at describing the procedures for the collection and use of personal data through this website, and is addressed to the users of the web services, electronically accessible at the web address:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">www.myacademic-id.eu</p> <p>related to the home page of the official website of the project MyAcademicID.</p>
	<p>Data Controller</p> <p>The Data Controller is EDUCatt <i>Ente per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario</i>, with registered office in Milan, Largo Agostino Gemelli n. 1, in the person of its General Manager (hereinafter the "Data Controller" or the "Institution").</p> <p>Cosimo Calabrese has been appointed as Data Protection Officer.</p> <p>For all the questions related to the processing of personal data and the exercise of the rights provided for by GDPR, the Data Controller may be contacted at the following e-mail address: projects@educatt.org.</p>
	<p>Purposes of the processing and legal basis</p> <p>The D.P.O. processes the personal data, exclusively of non-sensitive nature, communicated by the interested party while visiting the following website areas: "Contact"; "Events".</p> <p>In "Contact", data collection and use are made in order to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> fulfil the requests made by the interested party and provide the requested services. In accordance with Article 6 of GDPR, the legal basis for the data processing is the fulfilment of the services required by the user (point b). comply with a legal obligation, the D.P.O. is subject to; meet the obligations required by the law, by national and European Union regulations or by Authority orders. In accordance with Article 6 of GDPR, the legal basis for the data processing is in compliance with a legal obligation (point c). <p>In "Events", data collection and use are made in order to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> enrol the parties concerned to the events, meetings, conferences organized during the lifetime of the MyAcademicID project. In accordance with Article 6 of GDPR, the legal basis for the data processing is the fulfilment of the services required by the user (point b). inform interested parties about future initiatives and events, within the framework of the My Academic ID project. <p>In accordance with Article 6 of the GDPR, the legal basis for the processing is the consent of the interested party (point a).</p> <p>Apart from these data, freely provided by the user on the website, the browsing data - collected as a result of using our services - may also be processed. In particular:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - information about the device with which the user connects; - specific information concerning the device used to connect to the Internet (for example, the kind of device, information related to the mobile network, etc.); - log info. When using our services or viewing the content provided by the Controller, some information in the server's logs may be automatically collected and recorded. This information might include: the data related to the way in which our service is used, such as search queries; info related to Internet connection data, like IP addresses and all the other connected data; info on the events generated by the device, system activities, hardware settings, browser type and language, time and date of the queries and of the referring URL; the cookies that might identify the browser and the user's account uniquely. <p>All the partners involved in the project could use different technologies to collect and record information when the website is visited and/or a service is used which might require the delivery of one or more cookies or anonymous identifiers to the user's device.</p>
	<p>Object and type of data processing</p> <p>The D.P.O. processes the personal data, exclusively of non-sensitive nature, communicated by the interested party while visiting the website areas "Contact" and "Events", via email or when filling out special forms.</p> <p>The processing of the personal data for the mentioned purposes is done by means of automated or computer-based procedures, in respect of the rules of confidentiality and security provided by law, by the ensuing rules and by specially issued internal procedures.</p>

	<p>The processing Controller undertakes not to disclose the submitted data to unauthorized people or use them for purposes other than those specified above. These data can be produced only at the request of authorities entitled by law.</p> <p>The data are processed and stored at EDUCatt - Ente per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario dell'Università Cattolica, registered office in Milan (Italy), Largo Agostino Gemelli 1.</p>
	<p>Nature of data provision and consequences of consent to treatment</p> <p>All the data communicated by the interested party or sent while registering for an event are indispensable for the provision of the requested services. The users' personal identification data and their email address are, therefore, obligatory, as strictly connected to the nature of the required services.</p> <p>The data will be included in specific lists, necessary for the organization of the event. It follows that the consent to the processing of data is mandatory, and any refusal would put the Data Controller in the conditions of not being able to execute the requested services.</p> <p>Furthermore, the processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject, as specified in point b.</p> <p>The processing of the same data for information purposes on future initiatives and events within the My Academic ID project is optional and requires the consent of the interested party.</p>
	<p>Data communication and transfer</p> <p>The data can be communicated to the partners of the MyAcademicID project, to public and private individuals, physical or legal persons (legal, administrative and fiscal offices, computer companies, or others) that must be necessarily informed for the right fulfilment of the purposes of the project, for contractual, administrative and accounting purposes, as well as to guarantee the use and enjoyment of the website to those concerned.</p> <p>The data may also be communicated to other subjects, when the communication is provided for or required by law.</p> <p>The personal data are processed inside the territory of the European Union.</p>
	<p>Duration of the processing</p> <p>Personal data will be processed for no longer than it is necessary for the purposes for which the data were collected. In particular, it should be noted that the browsing data will be deleted within two years after their processing. In any case, a longer period of conservation is not precluded, when required by law or regulation.</p>
	<p>Data Subjects' Rights</p> <p>In accordance with GDPR (Articles 13, 15-22), data subjects have the following rights, in particular:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to obtain confirmation as to whether or not their personal data are being processed; - to access their data and the following information: processing purposes, categories of personal data, recipients and/or categories of recipients, conservation period; - to obtain correcting or integrating their personal data if they are incorrect; - to obtain cancellation of the data concerning them, in the circumstances laid down in Article 17 GDPR; - to withdraw their consent for the information processing, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on consent before their withdrawal; - to obtain that the personal data concerning them are only stored without any other use of them as provided for by Article 18 GDPR; - to obtain a copy of the data concerning them in commonly used electronic format, easily legible and interoperable, where their personal data are processed by electronic means, pursuant to a contract or with their consent. <p>If the subjects have any queries or comments, or if they want to exercise their rights, they can contact the Data Controller sending an email to projects@educatt.org.</p>
